SAINTS FUN FACTS

St John Baptist Vianney was born in France in 1786. After being drafted into the Army, he deserted and returned home and entered the seminary in 1812.

He was assigned to Emilly and in 1825 he became Curé, as pastor of Ays. He worked 16 to 18 hours a day upkping in the confessional, administering the Sacrament of Penance, or Reconciliation.

John died at Ays and was canonized in 1925 and was made patron saint of parish priests.
